“Salute” awards are presented to employees who go the extra mile in their roles within Chesley Brown International. We recognize many actions performed by officers in the normal course of a day go unnoticed. The following were recognized in this month’s Chairman’s Chat:

On 01-01-10 while patrolling Rockhill, Security Officer Mark DeSimio encountered a white male suspect who attempted to push past him and gain entry to the security vehicle. When the suspect was unsuccessful, he fled on foot. Security Officer DeSimio maintained visual contact with the suspect and called for assistance and police. Security Officer Stephanie Post responded along with KCPD who arrested the suspect who was found to have just attempted to break into a home damaging over \$1,500 in property in his attempt.

On the morning of January 11, 2010, Public Safety officers at the KC Power and Light District responded to fire sprinklers going off in the corridor of the KC Live! Block. Officers on scene observed large amounts of water building up in the ceiling and this water soon caused the ceiling tiles and insulation to collapse. They immediately cordoned off the area to prevent patrons from tripping over the debris or being hit by additional falling debris. Public Safety officers also coordinated with the manager of a restaurant and decided to evacuate the business for fear that additional ceiling collapses could occur inside. Officers assisted patrons in exiting the establishment and directed them to safe areas of the Live! Block and treated the wet areas with salt to prevent slip hazards due to the freezing temperatures.
