Both responded quickly to find a construction crew who had accidentally hit a sprinkler head causing it to break. In only minutes Cpl. Godfrey and Officer Brown were able to coordinate quickly a response to get the riser turned off causing the least amount of water damage as possible. Both were complimented later by Property Management, on how efficiently the issue was resolved. Due to their swift response time and detailed knowledge of the building systems, the officers greatly reduced a potential large amount of building damage.

Corporal Nick Obringer of The Waterfront Public Safety was issued a Salute on February 9th for working 24 hours straight during a 21 inch snowstorm. He also returned for his normal shift the next day.
