This is a process that the site had struggled with in the past when trying to pass along the exact whereabouts of burnt out lights to the maintenance staff.

The unique external lighting report that Officer Griffin created uses pictures of burned out lights taken by the overnight officers. This has eliminated the confusion maintenance has had in the past of trying to find which lights are burned out during the day, when all the lights are off.
