Presented to employees who go the extra mile in their roles within Chesley Brown International. We recognize many actions performed by officers in the normal course of a day go unnoticed. The following were recognized in this month's Chairman's Chat:

Security Officers Tim Kintigh, Luke McClure, Eric Pastor and Corporal Ernest Motten – Pennsylvania

The abovementioned officers made contact with a victim who stated her boyfriend had thrown her from his vehicle and taken her purse and cell phone. The officers were able to alert West Homestead Police and locate the vehicle which had been abandoned a short distance from the incident. In radio contact with West Homestead Police, officers were able to direct police to the location of the suspect and, after a brief foot chase and struggle, he was taken into custody. In addition to his other charges, the suspect was also in possession of illegal narcotics. The victim stated our officer made her feel very safe and secure during this incident.

Security Officers Jessica Hardy and Rosetta Shinault, Dispatchers Amanda Bendure and Estelle Chappell and Sergeant William Holbrook – Missouri

Officer Jessica Hardy observed a vehicle traveling at a high rate of speed enter a parking garage. Officer Hardy made contact with Sergeant Holbrook and Off-Duty Police Officer Rob Shorrock who checked the license plate and discovered the driver had an extraditable nationwide warrant as well as additional warrants for possession of narcotics. Police Officer Shorrock and Sgt. Holbrook contacted the suspect who fled the area on foot. Dispatchers Amanda Bendure and Estelle Chappell were able to follow the suspect via CCTV and coordinate with on-duty police officers as well as officers in the field. The suspect was detoured into Neptune Parking by Officer Rosetta Shinault where he was taken into custody by on and off-duty police officers and Sgt. Holbrook. The suspect was arrested for resisting arrest, a felony warrant for possession of narcotics, a probation violation and driving without a license.

Security Officers Dan Martin, Matt Downey and Sergeant Ron Rumble – Utah

Officers Dan Martin, Matt Downey and Sgt. Ron Rumble responded to a fire at an un-leased space. The officers found a fire inside the unoccupied space and realizing the fire was near a gas line, the officers made the quick decision to force entry into the space to extinguish the fire before the threat worsened and endangered patrons and employees of surrounding stores. The officers were

also able to quickly evacuate the surrounding stores and coordinate with responding emergency department to control the scene.
